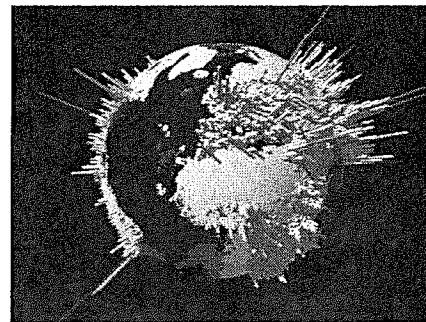


4.6 Growing, Growing, Gone

1930: 122.8

1950: 152.3

1970: 204.9
